In addition to the RI Foundation promotion in November, the Club Foundation decided to give an update on its status thus far. New policies were created, and were made available at Friday's lunch on the 18th, when Rod Hatter spoke. If you did not receive a copy, please let me know and I will provide you one. In addition to the new policies, Rod explained the different ways in which the Club Foundation can receive gifts. Judging by the "dear-in-headlights" look on a few new members' faces, and comments I received after the meeting, I want to clarify that no member is obligated to contribute to the Foundation in any way. The Club Foundation exists to provide a tax deductible donation source of the club for non-business owners that cannot write off expenses from Rotary activities or funds otherwise voluntarily gifted, as the club itself is not a 501(c)3. It also provides a manner in which large gifts may be received and held to, either, accumulate earnings that are to be distributed per the discretion of the gifter or club board, or be distributed per specific requests of the gifter. This brings me to the next topic I was asked to clarify. Jack Pugh has stipulated in the documents of his trust, via his attorney, that the Club Foundation receive a gift (amount to be determined) upon his death. This is not a hand-shake deal or spoken promise. Agreements have been signed, and I can assure you, as Jack's very good friend, our Foundation will indeed be receiving the gift.

I would like to thank the Club Foundation, again, and club members, for increasing the budget on the Holiday Meal Boxes. Ten additional families will be supported by this effort! Thank you Jeff and Pam E. for coordinating. Remember that the Goodie Boxes for the troops are being packed after lunch next week on December 9th. Please bring any of the items originally requested. Another blast will go out this week to remind you what those are. Number One Rule: No Chocolate. Thank you Jim L. and the Maxwells for coordinating.
